For the purposes of this Section, the district and college policies and procedures that have or will have “a significant effect on students” include the following: 1. grading policies; 2. codes of student conduct; 3. academic disciplinary policies; 4. curriculum development; 5. courses or programs which should be initiated or is continued; 6. processes for institutional planning and budget development; 7. standards and policies regarding student preparation and success; 8. student services planning and development; 9. student fees within the authority of the district to adopt; and 10. any other district and college policy, procedure or related matter that the district governing board determines will have significant effect on students.
