c. Cafe International – Monetary Request

♣ Date: April 21st, 2026

♣ Café International is an event that shares the languages and cultures - Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, and Spanish - that the World Languages department offers. Each language sets up a table with cultural and linguistic games that the public is encouraged to try. We also provide culturally appropriate food that is given for free to all that are interested. The funds will

be spent by each language/culture representative for food/snacks/sweets that represent that culture or cultures.

VP Harris asked for clarification of how much was fundraised for the event. It was clarified that \$450 was fundraised. He also asked for an itemized budget breakdown; there was no set budget breakdown as funds are divided between multiple faculty members. Additionally, VP Harris asked for a projected cost of total money estimated to be spent + records of spending last event. Clarified that receipts for reimbursement last event were submitted, just shy of \$600.

EVP Hussain asked for clarification if the amount requested is \$800. It was clarified that Cafe International is asking for \$800.

VP Penning asked VP Harris for the funds left to be spent on the Highlighted Communities budget. VP Harris clarified that there is \$2150 left out of \$3000 for the whole semester. Approving Cafe International's request would decrease the budget from \$2150 to \$1350.

EVP Hussain asked if the extra \$200 will be projected at this semester's event. VP Barnes asked in what way the event is going to be expanded. It was clarified that the extra \$200 will be expanded through the inclusion of more participants, including an increase in food and drinks + expansion in space for tables.

President Yaretzi Hernandez asked for clarification if these funds are for the rest of the year. VP Harris clarified these funds are from start of the school year to end, originally started at \$3000 beginning in fall and is now at \$2150. He personally thinks the request should be cut down to \$700 instead as ASG might not have enough money for the rest of the school year.

VP Penning asks Advisor Stephanie Linnander if ASG typically receives requests this big. She clarifies that Cafe International is one of the biggest events at Palomar College. Additionally, these types of requests are approved 4-6 weeks out, speaking historically.

VP Barnes, VP Penning, and Senator Crouch push for the full request of \$800 as requests these big will probably not be seen throughout the rest of the semester. Senator Crouch believes the \$100 cut is dismal.
