### a. Reallocation of ICC Funds

*Motion to open discussion for approval of reallocation of ICC funds: ICC Ambassador Blandon*

*Seconded: VP Barnes*

*Discussion:*

*VP Barnes presented the proposal to reallocate unused ICC funds towards the purchase of two large bulletin boards for the Student Union. He clarified he is not asking for any money, just to reallocate funds.*

*President Yaretzi Hernandez asked whether VP Harris had been consulted, in which VP Barnes claimed no and asked for approval now. VP Harris stated he would like to review the budget directly with VP Barnes before approving the reallocation of the funds.*

*VP Penning expressed he is in favor of the reallocation but thinks it's best to table until a proper facilities request is obtained and VP Harris has had a chance to review the budget.*

*ICC Ambassador Blandon clarified that facilities had been consulted after being invited to attend a committee meeting and that there would be no cost for installation once the boards are purchased.*

After reiterating he can not approve without reviewing the budget, VP Harris suggested for VP Barnes to bring a mockup for everyone else to see.

VP Barnes stated there is an ICC fund account with approximately \$5,000 and that a portion had been approved to be used by ICC. He asked for an official statement from the advisor, in which Advisor Stephanie Linnander stated the ASG budget goes to the VP of Finance and can not be asked regarding the situation. She clarified it is appropriate for any ASG business to be consulted with the VP of Finance directly and should not ask for information to be provided during the meeting. Therefore, there was a consensus to bring this up at a subsequent meeting.

VP Penning motioned to table the reallocation of ICC funds

VP Barnes presented the proposal to install two large bulletin boards downstairs in the Student Union. The boards are sourced from Home Depot and its estimated cost is \$600 total, \$300 each board. VP Barnes wants to approve the installation of the boards before buying. The purpose of the boards is to increase ICC and club activity engagement so students are aware of upcoming club events and meetings. ICC Ambassador Blandon noted he holds office hours Monday through Thursday and can ensure posted materials on the board are club affiliated.

Senator Farrington expressed his support in the idea, stating it would be beneficial for those who do not go to the NS building often.

President Yaretzi Hernandez asked for the clarification on whether ASG approval was needed. Advisor Stephanie Linnander clarified permanent installations like a bulletin board should be heard by ASG to provide feedback.

*VP Harris asked if there was a quote ready. ICC Ambassador Blandon clarified they do have a quote, but stated the point of the vote is to approve the installation of the bulletin boards from ASG as a whole.*
