The event will help students prepare for the upcoming Career Fair; including resume building and other various skill shops. She invited clubs to table at the event and shared a QR sign-up code for those interested.

a. Executive Reports – Three (3) Minutes Each

- i. President Yaretzi Hernandez

President Yaretzi Hernandez reported that she attended College Council this morning. She noted it was a relatively short meeting, with the primary business being adoption of new policy changes to AP policies.

- ii. Executive Vice President Rabab Hussain

EVP Hussain reported she has completed Onboarding for most but encouraged all remaining members to complete it as soon as possible as the end of the semester is near. During onboarding, she noticed some members don't have access to shared governance committees via Zoom or in-person. She reminded members that attendance at their respective shared governance committees is a requirement for members to take part

in ASG and to contact Stephanie or the committee members to be added. Additionally, EVP Hussain reported the shared folder for the End of the Year Report has not received contributions and has reminded members to start working on it. She asked members who already have access to add event photos including descriptions and is currently working on giving access to newer members. VPs are also encouraged to include goals for the next school year, whether or not one is passing the role on. She plans to set a hard deadline in coordination with Stephanie. Finally, she thanked everyone for being such an encouraging board and expressed her happiness to see most seats filled.

b. Trustee Report – Three (3) Minutes

i. Trustee Fridman

Trustee Fridman provided a report for last week and this week due to her absence in the last meeting. She reported attending the SSCCC General Assembly in San Francisco last week and gave a shoutout to VP Penning for his work on the resolutions. She also met with Dr. Amrik Johal and Director of the Palomar Foundation, Stacy Rungaitis, regarding memorial funding for LaCraigory Garrett. Trustee Fridman also hosted the LaCraigory Garrett Memorial Subcommittee meeting on Tuesday, scheduling meetings to every 1st and 3rd Tuesday of the month. Three options to memorialize LaCraigory Garrett have been chosen and members have until April 17th to vote via the poll sent through email. Additionally, she has a follow-up meeting with Dr. Tina Recalde scheduled to discuss the next steps in the governing board's involvement. She also stated meeting with the Presidential Search Committee along with ICC Ambassador Blandon to learn more about the process. This past week, she had the honor of speaking at the opening of the new Palomar Pride Center. Finally, she reminded ASG that the next governing board meeting is Tuesday, April 14.

c. Advisor Reports – Three (3) Minutes Each

This week, Advisor Stephanie Linnander attended Craig's Subcommittee. She affirmed all items of honoring LaCraigory Garrett have been thoroughly explored and is best to go forward with the committee's wishes. There is the option of looking into other possible items, but the committee has done significant work in choosing the three options available. She thanked Trustee Fridman for the support regarding the committee. She also reported that Candidate Forum is next Monday and Tuesday and is highly recommended for candidates and board members to attend and support peers who are running this upcoming semester. Advisor Linnander also reported that commencement preparations are underway. Processional marshals have been confirmed. President Yaretzi Hernandez will serve as the Student Commencement Address Speaker while EVP Hussain will serve as the Pledge of Allegiance Speaker. Additionally, she attended Finance Committee this week and is moving forward with the tentative budget. She reminded members that Zoom attendance does not count towards quorum and that in-person attendance is critical in passing budgets. Without meeting quorum, budgets can not be passed, highlighting the importance of in-person attendance for the final weeks of the semester. However, she thanked those who communicated their absences and encouraged all members to have a balance between schoolwork and ASG.

There were votes on changes to BP 2725 and BP 2730, which included policy changes to include the Student Trustee and health and welfare benefits for students. He also met with Riham from Basic Needs to discuss potential collaborations with ASG next year through events. Additionally, the Finance Committee met yesterday, and he reported he will be working on the at tentative budget this weekend. He is appreciative of those who showed up and is hoping to meet again before next Friday's ASG meeting. If that isn't possible, he plans to send out an email to members the budget created to obtain feedback.

VP Barnes reported that Senator Esteban Perez has volunteered to serve as the ICC Secretary. He also reported on the ICC's work regarding ongoing discussions about General Education changes, specifically the potential removal of American History & Institutions and Health & Fitness from Palomar's local GE requirements. The committee is committed to moving forward with the implementation of GE Area 7: Lifelong Learning. Today's ICC meeting was spent revising rubrics and criteria for classes to count towards Area 7. The committee is moving forward through the details of how to move this issue forward while also welcoming feedback from ASG.
