Trustee Fridman reported she has been continuously attending the VPFAS meetings. Additionally, she assisted with setup for the Cinco de Mayo tabling event. She noted that the scholarship criteria for the LaCraigory Garrett Memorial Scholarship have been finalized and will be sent to the Palomar Foundation. She met with Dr. Tina Recalde to discuss the upcoming Governing Board and attended the Institutional Self-Evaluation training presented by ACCJC, which brought up concerns regarding what students are getting from higher education and how institutions can improve.

Advisor Stephanie Linnander reported that the campus was alerted early in the week by the Chancellor's Office about a cyberattack targeting Canvas and other higher education platforms. She states this is a nationwide issue which has affected multiple schools. Some colleges have been able to restore Canvas, however Palomar College has not. Guidance has been issued to all faculty, directing them not to change their course modalities or delivery methods at this time. Students are encouraged to contact their instructors directly via email and to use alternate platforms such as Google or Microsoft 365 tools to submit assignments as needed. Canvas should be considered completely unreliable and unusable until further notice. The district is actively working to secure Canvas and is treating this as a top priority. Advisor Linnander noted that students currently impacted should work with their instructors and reach out if they encounter issues. Furthermore, she also reported that election results are available and will be addressed by Senator Grimm with further details. She expressed her excitement about the ASG Banquet at 6:00PM that evening and recommended for members to arrive a few minutes early.
